All abstracts must be submitted as a Microsoft Word document, using Arial 12pt and including: (1) Title (20 words max.), (2) Presentation format (Oral/Poster), (3) Authors (Smith, P. G.) (Mark with * the presenter’s name); (4) Institution’s name and address; (5) Author’s email; (6) Abstract (300 words max.) including objectives, methods, results and conclusions; (6) Keywords (3-10).

Please send abstracts attached to an email entitled “IOS 2017 – Author’s name” to: bmaruri@concyteq.edu.mx. A confirmation of receipt will be sent. Only one oral presentation can be submitted per author.

Poster presentations: Posters should have a size of 150 x 100 cm (vertical presentation). IOS, Jardín Botánico Regional de Cadereyta and CONCYTEQ logotypes should be included.

The “Semidesierto Queretano-Hidalguese biodiversity historical route” pays homage to those national and foreign botanists and explorers which have contributed to the knowledge of the Flora of this region, and whose effort has been crucial for the understanding of succulents in Mexico.

The route is designed for a two-day field trip, visiting the locations of Cadereyta de Montes that Joseph N. Rose and Fernando Altamirano Carbajal explored in the early twentieth century, along with other sites of distribution of emblematic species collected by Thomas Coulter, around 1825.

The journey includes the recognition of a wide variety of species of Cactaceae, many of them linked to prominent names in Botany as De Candolle, Ehrenberg, Hildmann, Werdermann, Glass and Hunt. It is a unique opportunity to see the semiarid landscape of Central Mexico in a journey of scientific knowledge, culture, history and tales around the campfire.

Should you wish to participate, please include in your luggage field shoes, long sleeves, a hat, sun-block, mosquito repellent and sunglasses.

The types of vegetation that will be visited, among others, are: crassicaule, rosetophyllous and microphyllous shrubs. The following species of interest are expected to be found: *Agave striata*, *Ariocarpus kotschoubeyanus*, *Astrophytum ornatum*, *Dasyliirion longissimum*, *Echinocactus grusonii*, *Echinocactus platyacanthus*, *Echinocereus schmollii*, *Ferocactus histrix*, *Ferocactus latispinus*, *Isolatocereus dumortieri*, *Mammillaria compressa*, *Mammillaria herrerae*, *Mammillaria longimamma*, *Mammillaria sempervivi*, *Mammillaria uncinata*, *Myrtillocactus geometrizans*, *Opuntia kleiniae*, *Opuntia leucotricha*, *Opuntia stenopetala*, *Thelocactus hastifer*, *Turbinicarpus pseudomacrochele*, among others.
